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

An activity for students to identify if the following images represent ecosystems or not.

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

Slide 4 - No, animals that live in Zoos are not in an ecosystem

Slide 5 - Yes, caves are entire ecosystems

Slide 6 - Yes, a reef is an ecosystem

Slide 7 - Yes, this is an ecosystem

Slide 8 - No, this glass of water is not an ecosystem

Slide 9 - Yes, this is an ecosystem, even though it is made by humans, because it attracts and sustains wildlife

Slide 10 - Yes, this is a desert ecosystem

Slide 11 - Yes, this is an ecosystem in the Arctic

Slide 12 - Yes, this is an ecosystem

Slide 13 - No, an electricity pole is not an ecosystem

Slide 14 - No, a cat and a person are not an ecosystem
